The Get High On Nature Society (GHON) passed a resolution to dissolve. As a result, a decision has been made to establish an annual scholarship with the remaining funds for graduating students pursuing environmental studies to be administered by School District #8, Kootenay Lake.

The criteria established by the Society is as follows:

- Applicants must be graduates of LVR, Mt. Sentinel or Salmo Secondary
- Applicants must apply to the S.D. #8 Scholarship committee and provide the following:
  - (a) A reference from their school
  - (b) Proof of registration in an environmental studies program (prior to scholarship being paid out).
  - (c) A one-page statement as to why the applicant is interested in pursuing environmental studies
  - (d) A list of previous involvement in environmental activities
- Deadline for application: April 30<sup>th</sup>
- The successful applicant may defer initiation of his or her studies up to 18 months
- One five hundred dollar (\$500.00) scholarship is to be awarded annually until the principal and interest is exhausted.

The total amount to be transferred to School District #8 (Kootenay Lake) is Eight Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$8,600.00) for the establishment of this scholarship. An official receipt from the School District will be needed for our records.
