

NDTA BURSARY

1. Bursaries in the amount of \$2000 will be awarded annually to a child or grandchild of active or retired NDTA members.
2. The applicant for the bursary will apply in the following manner:
 - a. Provide their name and relationship to an NDTA member or former member.
 - b. Provide the name of the current school or post-secondary institution (if applicable)
 - c. Provide one letter of reference from an adult who can write knowledgeably about the applicant, including aspects such as talents, potential in their chosen field, their motivation and/or their attitude.
 - d. Provide a concise (maximum 300 words) statement about their post-secondary plans and career plans. (Tell us why it is important to receive post-secondary training)
 - e. **Optional:** Provide one other document that helps to illustrate their ability and potential. For example, an original poem, a photograph of a car you have refinished, a one-page set of original photographs, a photograph of original artwork, etc.
3. Payment of the bursary will be made to the recipient upon proof of paid tuition to a post secondary institution.
4. The bursary must be claimed within one year of receiving the bursary.
5. An individual may apply for the bursary more than once BUT may only receive the bursary once.
6. The bursary is intended for an undergraduate program at a university, a diploma program, a tech school program or a college program.
7. The bursary exists only as long as the NDTA exists.
8. Applicants for the following academic year should apply by April 30.
9. The NDTA Executive will annually establish a committee of three who will review the applications and determine the recipients.
10. The selection committee should consist of a teacher, an NDTA executive member and a community member (someone who is not an active member). This should be a retired NDTA member.
11. The decision of the selection committee is final.
12. The NDTA will make available \$2000 for bursaries which will be divided amongst all eligible candidates with the maximum for any candidate being \$500.
