WORK EXPERIENCE 12 LV Rogers Secondary School

This four credit course is designed to enable you to explore careers of your choice and to gain valuable employability skills. It requires a strong commitment to self-initiative and responsibility. You are required to complete 100 hours of volunteer work experience. You may work at one or several placements and complete the hours during school time, after school or on weekends. It is the student's responsibility to keep track of hours worked. Credit will be given to documented hours only.

Up to 20 hours can be credited for previous work provided it is well documented in the Journal format and verified by a supervisor or employer.

You may also find other benefits through work placements such as:

- connections with employers that may lead to future employment.
- learning new skills that enhance your employability.
- practical work experience hours for entrance into some college or university programs
- references for your resume
